

Karridale is a late maturing black seeded sub clover, taking 139 days from sowing to flowering. It has good burr burial strength and increased hardseededness over Woogenellup. The variety is suited to higher rainfall environments due to its late maturity and time to flower. Karridale has good resistance to diseases with a resistant rating for Clover Scorch, Pythium, Fusarium and Rhizoctonia Root Rots, and races 0 and 2 of Phytophthora Root Rot. Karridale also has very good insect pest resistance.
