

Option for resistant ryegrass management control

Tetrone originated from the same source of germplasm as the well known Tetila ryegrass (i.e. the Western Wolth's region of Holland). The germplasm is the true annual form of Italian Ryegrass. Tetrone is strictly annual and has high levels of winter production, particularly when planted early. Tetrone has later maturity than Tetila and consequently higher nutritive value (crude protein and metabolisable energy) for longer into spring. It is extremely frost resistant and has excellent cool season growth making great winter feed.
